This study examines if low doses of a drug called levetiracetam (LEV) can help improve brain signaling in people **at risk** of dementia.




## What does the study involve?

- Cognitive testing & questionnaires
- Blood work & genetic testing
- Brain imaging at Toronto Western Hospital
- Daily medication: LEV for 4 weeks and placebo for 4 weeks

Compensation is available to cover transportation/parking costs and your time

## Eligibility

- 55-85 years of age
- Family history of dementia in a parent or sibling
- Concerns about memory
- No diagnosis of cognitive impairment or dementia
- Willing to undergo memory testing
- Able to undergo magnetic resonance imaging (MRI)
